a. $\theta = 0$



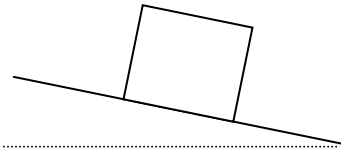

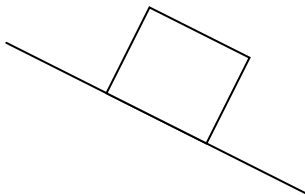

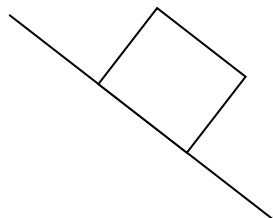

2. Two lifeguards pull on ropes attached to a raft. If they pull in the same direction, the raft experiences a net external force of 300 N to the right. If they pull in opposite directions, the raft experiences a net external force of 135 N to the left.
- Draw a free-body diagram representing the raft for each situation. This includes the forces, $F_{\text{net},x}$ and $F_{\text{net},y}$
 - Find the force exerted by each lifeguard on the raft. (Disregard any other forces acting on the raft.)
3. A 5 kg bucket of water is raised from a well by a rope. If the upward acceleration of the bucket is 1.2 m/s^2 , find the force exerted by the rope on the bucket of water.
4. A boat moves through the water with a $2.9 \times 10^3 \text{ N}$ forward push by the motor, and a kinetic friction force caused by the water of $1.9 \times 10^3 \text{ N}$.
- What is the acceleration of the 1200 kg boat?
 - If it starts from rest, how far will it move in 3 s?
 - What will its velocity be at the end of this time interval?
